#### **Board Reports**

## Audra Hoebler – Recording Secretary

- On April 13 at 6:30pm at the OES library, FPAC (Facilities Planning Advisory Council) will present the CIP (Capital Improvement Plan) that has been approved for Fairfax County.
- At the next PTA meeting, May 18, we hope to have Ann Dolin speak; she is the founder of Educational Connections.
- At the the June 8 PTA meeting we will vote on the slate for next year's Board. The slate must be advertised by April 28.

#### **Treasurer – Marcie Martin**

- Skate Night revenue is down; February's date was canceled due to weather.
- Yearbook sales are complete.
- The teachers' submissions for their mini grants (PTA has given money to each grade for enrichment purposes) have been approved and we are in the process of reimbursing now. We gave additional money to the reading department because we had extra funds. The remaining funds will be used at the PTA's discretion. Fifth and sixth grade have yet to submit.
- Most teachers have used their teacher support money (\$200). There will be no reimbursement without receipts.
- There have been requests for licensure reimbursements. These will be reviewed
  on a case-by-case basis dependent on funds available. Fairfax County used to
  pay for the transfer of licensure from a different state but with budget cut, this has

- ceased. It will be the PTA's recommendation that we do not reimburse for this after this year.
- The OES 5K has sponsorships exceeding \$10,000. Registration for the event is going well.

# **VP of Programs – Mary Pat Julian**

- Spring programs will be kicking off after Spring Break. The programs are similar to the programs offered in the Fall. The new karate program, led by Jim Miller, filled up immediately.
- We will offer two summer camps
  - Two week art program (full day and half day) with Emma Brooks and Sarah O'Grady.
  - One week Camp Invention with Mr. Goehrke.

# **VP of Fundraising – Laurel Donaldson (**Laurel was not present and Amy Allen gave the report)

- Family Fun Night was a huge success and we raised between \$11-12K. It was
  slightly more successful than last year with a bit less work because the teacher
  experiences were not included in the auction but will be raffled off in May.
- The Mixed Bag class winners will have an ice cream party on April 9. Scoops 2
   U is donating the ice cream.
- Scoops 2U is unable to attend our 5K; we are looking into other options.
- We will have a book fair fundraiser held at Barnes & Noble next October. OES will receive 20% of all sales (including food). At the fundraisers we hope to have teacher readings, face painting and possibly a book signing by a local author.
- We will hold off until next year for our brick fundraiser.

- The FPAC meeting is April13 (see above).
- We are going to looking into having a gravel track put it on the field. Marshall Road Elementary has one; it is environmentally friendly and permeable.
- The school times for the 2015-26 school year have been changed to 9:05am to 4:00pm (rather than 3:55).

  to miss one more day of school to be able to apply for the waiver.
  - Many feel that with this later start date kids are at a disadvantage as they have less time to prepare for exams and SOLs as the quarters are not equally weighed.
