Student Council/PTA Fundraiser: Currently ongoing, through June 15th. So far, in addition to food being donated directly, \$380 has been raised. More expected before Monday. Great job!

Hershey Park Tickets: all were refunded because of the uncertainty of park openings with the pandemic

Autism t-shirts: arrived after stay at home orders, but all have been distributed via school pickup (along with items from desks and classrooms)

School Supplies: Nicole White added Special Ed classes to School Supply online ordering. Currently have two separate lists/boxes, one for each scenario of learning (in school and distance learning). The vendor will monitor the school learning decisions as they are made. Vendor has committed to fulfilling all orders, but cannot accept add-on items such as hand sanitizer and Clorox wipes due to shortages. It is still ok to order additional traditional school supplies like pencils, scissors, etc. Nicole White will continue to coordinate School Supplies offering through summer.

Enrichment: Ellie Zadeh explained that the vendor is looking into providing all programs online. Classes with individual activities (like coding) and some games (like chess) lend themselves to online offerings. But there will be no group or team activities because of the social distancing guidelines.

NOTE: discussions of calendar events, fundraising activities, and budget spending for next year were tabled as those decisions will be predicated on restrictions/allowances as determined by FCPS in accordance with the Coronavirus Pandemic Reopening Phase guidelines.

Principal Chris Kelley thanked the PTA Board for everything done this year. Said she couldn't have asked for more, especially with the challenge of the school closing.

Karen Rose thanked the Board with a special mention of Nicole White and Mimi Chou "graduating" from the school. They will be missed.
