# OES PTA Meeting

### Special Presentation

Joy called the meeting to order at 8:35am and introduced our presenter, OES Reading Specialist Andrea Caggianelli. Mrs. Caggianelli's presentation will be posted at a later time for those not at the meeting. She talked about the reading and literacy strategies that OES uses currently, and answered questions from the audience. Her main tips were for parents to try to instill a love of reading in their children, leave the decoding to the teachers instead of trying to teach it at home (unless you are a trained professional), and to utilize summer reading programs through Fairfax County libraries and places like Barnes & Noble. She also said that while there is not a specific grade that children should be fully reading by, because all children develop differently, that early intervention is key and that OES tries to focus on that. The state of Virginia says that technically, children should be reading fully by 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. In terms of spelling, she said that having students sound out letters and sounds is great, but also to read the text back to the child so they can model the parent and improve fluency. In terms of tablets versus physical books, Mrs. Caggianelli thinks there is definitely a place for tablets and electronic means but she prefers books in hands so that students can refer back to certain pages and passages, use sticky notes, etc.

#### PTA Business

The PTA is actively looking for volunteers to join the board and take on board positions. We will have many open positions for next year as many board members are vacating their positions. The last PTA meeting for the year will be in May and is virtual; we will be holding elections for new board officers at that time.
